Dear Omega Alpha Academy Parents/Guardians:

In light of the recent development regarding COVID-19, Omega Alpha Academy continues to maintain constant communication and is working collaboratively with Cochise County's Superintendent Jacqui Clay, the Arizona Department of Education, Arizona State Superintendent Kathy Hoffman, and Cochise County's Health and Social Services Department to keep our students, staff, and community informed and safe in regards to the Corona Virus (COVID-19).

Omega Alpha Academy has also performed, and is performing, the following procedures:

- 1. A School Governing Board meeting was held to determine if our school should be closed. A decision was made to continue with our normal school schedule and monitor the situation. Pending further development of the virus, changes may be made to the school schedule.
- 2. The school health assistant continues to monitor current COVID-19 updates and reports daily to Mr. Frisby. Our health assistant is also being more vigilant with regards to students that may display any symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- 3. A COVID-19 information letter was sent to all of our parents/guardians with information pertaining to this matter. If applicable, additional letters will be sent home with updated information.
- 4. Our Information Technology Department is currently researching possible on-line courses or related courses for our students in the event of a school closure.
- 5. Our cafeteria supervisor has been briefed and is prepared for the possibility of having sack breakfast and lunches in the event of a school closure
- 6. The School Maintenance Department has been sterilizing all door handles or any surface areas that our students come in contact with during the school day.
- 7. Our cleaning crew continues to thoroughly disinfect all surface areas that student come in contact with throughout the school day.
- 8. Omega Alpha Academy's website will also be updated regularly to keep parents/guardians informed of any changes regarding COVID-19.

Cochise County has not had any confirmed cases of COVID19 and anticipates continuing operations as normal.
